He joined the Metropolitan Police on 11th August 1924 and served in 'G' Division (Finsbury) and 'K' Division (Stepney), he retired from the Met on 16th February 1951 with exemplary conduct, and died in 1974. Documentation includes Birth, Marriage and Death certificates, Army Discharge and Character certificates (first enlistment) Discharge and Character certificates, Soldiers Service and Pay Book (second enlistment), British Mercantile Marine Identity and Service certificate, Metropolitan Police Service Certificate signed by the Assistant Commissioner, two original photographs of Mr Cooper while a P.C. in 'G' Division, Mr Coopers 1960's/70's British passport with one visa stamp for the Soviet Union. A fine grouping to a very interesting man.</p>

An intriguing Visitors book of German Third Reich interest, the book, (which is believed to be from the official residence of Dietrich Klagges, Ministerpräsident of the Free State of Brunswick), is of very good quality and was obtained by a British soldier at the end of World War Two, there are around one hundred signature's signed in the first six pages of the book including ♦ A Rosenberg 24.11.40 ♦, Alfred Rosenberg was a high ranking Nazi politician and at one time editor of the Voelkischer Beobachter, the official Nazi newspaper, who was leader of the Foreign Policy Office of the N.S.D.A.P and Reichs Minister for the occupied Eastern Territories, sentenced to death at Nuremberg in 1946 he was executed by hanging for war crimes and crimes against humanity, There is also the signature and note of thanks for his "repeated hospitality" by Baldur von Schirach, Nazi politician and head of the Hitler Youth between 1931 - 1940, after active service in the army he later became Gauleiter of Vienna where he was involved with the deportation of the city's Jewish population, he was convicted of crimes against humanity at the Nuremberg trials and sentenced to 20 years in prison, other names in the book include Klagge, Herzig, Blick. Urban, Jobst, Lehmann, Hesse (a Wilhelm Hesse was District Leader of Brunswick between 1933-45) Pauch, Frau Paula Strohbach, several SS officers including an SS-Obersturmbannführer (Lieutenant Colonel) Kellermann, and what appears to be Karl Fiehler (a Karl Fiehler was the Lord Mayor of Munich between 1933-45), the book is bound in a leather and marble effect cover and measures 28.5 x 23 cm, it is held in a leather and fabric covered custom made box The vendor provides the following information, This book along with several other items was obtained by my father in Germany in the latter stages of World War 2. He was recruited into the army in 1939 and was involved throughout for the duration of hostilities finally coming home in 1945. As is often the case old soldiers didn't want to talk about what went on during their war experiences and my father was just like that. However when we asked him about where the items including the visitors book he had brought home with him came from he was more forthcoming. Evidently he was based in Wolfenbittel which is south of Brunswick in Lower Saxony after the area had been liberated by the allies and he spent some time there presumably controlling the area to suppress any resistance. He told us that the book and all the other items he had brought home in a large black box came from the President of Brunswick's residence which presumably must be in Brunswick. Dietrich Klagges had been Ministerpräsident of the Braunschweig Free State which is where this visitors book came from along with two photos of him with his family who remained in the house after Klagges had departed. This book has been in my family since my father returned from the war. His name is Charles Samuel Beverley and he was in the Argyll & Sutherland Highlanders; he reached the rank of Sergeant and his service number was: 11415403. He spent the war in various locations in Belgium, Holland and finally Germany. After the war he returned to his original occupation as a Bank Clerk in London and he died in 1969. The two photographs referred to appear to have been taken

on the same day and show Dietrich Klagges in the uniform of an SS Brigadefuhrer (Brigadier), in one he is standing with his family and staff including an orderly in white mess jacket showing the rank of SS-Unterscharfuhrer (Corporal)
