W D Storey (late 19th/early 20th Century) Portrait of Oliver Cromwell (1599-1658), oil on canvas, signed & dated 1900, framed 60cm x 72cm after the original by Sir Peter Lely (1618-1680), Galleria Palatina (Palazzo Pitti), Florence. Also included framed extract from Howe's Walks in Florence II, p. 400, copied out by W D Storey & signed by him, 1900: Pitti Palace, Florence. One of the most interesting pictures is no 408 a portrait of Oliver Cromwell by Sir Peter Lely. The story connected with this picture adds to its interest. When the persecution of the Waldensian Protestants (whose suffering Milton has immortalized in his beautiful ode) had reached its height the Lord Protector of England determined to arrest its course, he accordingly sent a message to the Pope Alexander VII that if these barbarities did not cease he would send the English Fleet up the Tiber. The result was an order to the Duke of Savoy to stay his hand. The Grand Duke of Tuscany Ferdinand II was so struck by the courage & character of Cromwell that he requested him to sit for this picture which Lely then a young man painted.
